



Membership Fees

Membership fees:

The Acting Membership fee for 12 months is £150. This can be paid as £90 for the first 6 months, and £60 for the subsequent 6 months if you decide to do another show during this period. Membership payments are due on 1st January and 1st July and the 12 month period can start from either of those dates.

There are also different rates for non-acting members and student members (see the table below):

Acting Member (for 12 months)	£150
Acting Member (for 6 or 12 months)	1 st 6 months: £90 Subsequent 6 months: £60
Non-Acting Member (for 12 months)	£30
Student Acting Member (in full-time education) (for 6 or 12 months)	1 st 6 months: £30 Subsequent 6 months: £20

Concessionary fees are available at the discretion of an Officer of the Committee and the Membership Secretary.

Any audition fees will be deducted from the membership fee.

If a non-acting member decides to join a show that is performed during the year of their membership, their non-acting membership fee will be deducted from their acting membership fee.

On the very rare occasions that we do a second show within a 6 month period, that show is included in the membership fee.

If you perform with us for a fundraising show, membership is free.
